

Child sex abuse lawsuit filed v. school head

Principal repeatedly violated an eight year old girl

After thorough investigation, he was arrested yesterday

Attorney praises law enforcement; urges others to “speak up now”

WHAT

At a sidewalk news conference, attorneys for child molestation victims will

--- announce the filing of a new child sex abuse lawsuit against a just-arrested school principal,

--- urge others who’ve been hurt by the high profile man to call law enforcement, and

--- prod current and former school staff who may have seen or suspected child sex crimes to contact police and prosecutors immediately.

WHEN

TODAY, Thursday, September 8, 2:30 p.m.

WHERE

Outside the Sacramento County Superior courthouse, 720 Ninth Street, Sacramento, CA 95814.

WHO

Two Sacramento attorneys who have represented hundreds of child sex abuse victims.

WHY

The family of a young girl who was repeatedly sexually abused by Principal Robert Benson Adams at the Creative Frontiers School is filing a new civil lawsuit today.

The suit alleges that Adams (“Mr. Bob”) sexually abused an eight-year old female student during the 2010 / 2011 academic year. On multiple occasions, Mr. Bob removed the girl (whom he described as one of his “favorite special students”) from her classroom and sexually abused her in his office and on “walks” around

the school. The complaint further alleges that Mr. Bob told to the girl's mother he had expertise in psychology and thereafter provided his diagnostic impressions of the eight year-old girl. In fact, Mr. Bob was not, and is not, qualified to perform counseling or make diagnostic psychological evaluations. Mr. Bob's actions were all part of a pattern and practice of removing girls from the classroom, so Mr. Bob could sexually abuse them.

“The girl's mother is concerned about the decade of child abuse at Creative Frontiers and the well-being of the other girls who may have been abused by Mr. Bob,” said her attorney Dr. Joseph C. George of Sacramento. “It is unconscionable for a principal to take advantage of and sexually abuse his young students. This girls' brave mother wants anyone who has suffered any abuse by Mr. Bob to contact the Citrus Heights Police Department (916) 727-5500 or (916) 727-5524.”

George notes that high profile accused child molesters often hire expensive defense lawyers, exploit technicalities in the law, and escape conviction (or get short sentences), only to molest again. He's strongly urging anyone who saw, suspected or suffered Adams' crimes to help police and prosecutors successfully convict and imprison him.

The ten page lawsuit seeks unspecified damages. The California Department of Social Services shut down Creative Frontiers, a private preschool and elementary school in July.
